Information for Clerkship and Internship Applicants

Judicial Internships:

Overview

Judicial interns work closely with Judge Kuo and her law clerks, and will have the opportunity to observe various court proceedings in addition to producing substantive legal work. Applicants must be current law students who are interested in federal court litigation and possess strong legal research and writing skills.

Academic year internships (spring or fall) may be part-time or full-time. Summer internships are full-time for 8-10 weeks. Start and end dates are flexible.

How to Apply

Interested applicants should e-mail the following materials to kuo_applications@nyed.uscourts.gov: (1) cover letter, (2) current resume, (3) law school transcript, (4) a writing sample, preferably a piece of legal writing, no more than 10 pages in length (preferably shorter) and (5) the names, e-mail addresses, and telephone numbers of three professional references, including at least one faculty member at the applicant's law school.

Deadlines

Spring and Fall:

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis, but must be submitted by December 15th for the spring and July 15th for the fall.

Summer:

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis beginning on January 15th.

Additional Information

The Court is unable to provide compensation to interns. Interns are encouraged to seek outside sources of funding, if necessary. In addition, summer interns are responsible for securing their own housing in the New York City area.

Clerkships:

Prospective clerkship applicants should consult OSCAR (<https://oscar.uscourts.gov>) to determine whether Judge Kuo is currently hiring. All applications must be submitted via OSCAR.
